The Opportunity

We are seeking a registered nurse for the position of Nursing Director. This is a permanent part-time position with minimal hours during the winter months and increasing hours leading up to and during the summer medical camp season.

This position will oversee our camp medical facility for children attending camp with life threatening or chronic illnesses and disabilities. Responsibilities include:

- Overseeing the ranch health centre, equipment, medications, and supplies
- Reviewing medical application forms, needs and requirements
- Recruiting volunteer medical staff
- Directing volunteer medical staff
- Liaising with volunteer medical advisory to stay informed on day-to-day operations

Pediatric experience preferred.

The majority of your responsibilities may be carried out on-site at our Vancouver head office or working from home. During summer medical camp season (end of June through August) attendance on site at the ranch for check in and check out of campers is required. On-site accommodations are available for all medical personal in our brand-new nurses' residence or you may choose to stay off-site.
